#### Statement of Issue:

The Public Works Department seeks Commissioner approval to trade- in 2 ER&R assets that are past life cycle and require continuous repairs. Broom #906 recently had an accident that was the result of a massive differential failure, it now requires over \$6,000 in repairs. Broom #827 is a 10-year asset that is 2 years over its intended life. Both of these items are vital to the County Roads team's ability to serve the taxpayers and keep the roads free of debris. The value of the trade- ins will help offset the purchase cost of the new equipment. The new equipment is being purchased through WA State Department of Enterprise Services, a purchasing cooperative that adheres to the competitive bid requirements of Washington State.
