Oil City Road - Six Mile Creek Culvert Replacement Oil City Road MP 5.96, County Road No. 134309

Statement of Issue: Create a county project known as the Oil City Road - Six Mile Creek Culvert Replacement.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: The Six Mile Creek Culvert Replacement is a transportation improvement project included in the officially adopted 2025-2030 Transportation Improvement Program as Item No. 27. This project will remove the fish passage barrier and improve county road infrastructure by replacing the culvert at Oil City Road MP 5.96 with a new bridge or concrete box culvert. This project is being funded and managed by Trout Unlimited. Jefferson County will provide assistance with right-of-way acquisition, and coordination with design and construction.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The total estimated cost for Jefferson County right-of-way assistance, and coordination on design and construction is \$13,644. The design and construction coordination will be funded at 100% by NOAA through a reimbursable, subrecipient agreement with Trout Unlimited. Jefferson County will contribute \$2,000 to Right-of-Way assistance from the County Road Fund. The construction cost is estimated at \$3,820,000 and will be entirely funded by Trout Unlimited.

Recommendation: The Board is requested to sign one original of the Resolution to Create County Project.
