## **MINUTES**

## Regular Meeting - January 17, 2023, 9:00 a.m.

Jefferson County Courthouse – Commissioners' Chambers 1820 Jefferson Street, Port Townsend, WA (Hybrid)

**CALL TO ORDER:** Chair Greg Brotherton, Commissioner Kate Dean and Commissioner Heidi Eisenhour participated in the meeting. Chair Brotherton called the meeting to order at the appointed time. He shared two Martin Luther King Jr. quotes with the public in honor of Martin Luther King Day.

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** Chair Brotherton called for public comments, and thirteen comments were received. The Commissioners addressed the comments and also reviewed written comments received.

**PROCLAMATION re: Declaration of Rights for the Southern Resident Orcas:** The Commissioners reviewed the draft proclamation and made edits. They agreed to review the Consent Agenda while Commissioner Dean incorporated edits into the proclamation.

**APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF THE CONSENT AGENDA:** Commissioner Dean moved to approve the items on the Consent Agenda as presented. Commissioner Eisenhour seconded the motion which carried by a unanimous vote.

## PROCLAMATION re: Declaration of Rights for the Southern Resident Orcas -

Continued: The Commissioners reviewed the final edits to the proclamation incorporated by Commissioner Dean. All three Commissioners read aloud the proclamation. Chair Brotherton called for public comments, and none were received. Commissioner Eisenhour moved to approve the Declaration of Rights for the Southern Resident Orcas as amended. Commissioner Dean seconded the motion which carried by a unanimous vote. Individuals from the audience, and some who were dressed up as Orca whales, had their photo taken with the Commissioners.

**COMMISSIONERS' BRIEFING SESSION:** Commissioner Dean discussed recent meetings she attended.

**PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATE:** Public Health Officer Dr. Allison Berry provided information on the viruses circulating in Jefferson County. Emergency Management Director Willie Bence was not present to give the Emergency Management update.

The meeting was recessed at 10:08 a.m. and reconvened at 10:18 a.m. with all three Commissioners present.

**COMMISSIONERS' BRIEFING SESSION - Continued:** The Commissioners continued discussing recent meetings they attended and reviewed upcoming meetings.

**DISCUSSION re: Priorities for Allocating Remaining County American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds:** The Commissioners reviewed a proposed priorities list for allocating ARPA funds. After discussion, Chair Brotherton called for public comments, and none were received.

Commissioner Dean moved to approve the guidelines and release them to the public for distributing the remainder of ARPA funds. Commissioner Eisenhour seconded the motion which carried by a unanimous vote.

Clerk Gallaway noted that the deadline for publishing in the legal paper of record had been missed as deadlines for submittal are on Mondays, and Monday was a holiday. She stated that the ad for the ARPA request for proposals would be published on January 25, 2023. She also noted that the same deadline issue applies for Consent Agenda Items No. 1 and 4 as well. The Commissioners stated they were in favor of a February 10, 2023 deadline.



County Administrator Mark McCauley noted that the proposal indicates a receipt of upcoming funding, which is not guaranteed, so he would like verbiage to reflect that. The Board will review the ARPA last call for proposals document during the afternoon session, with the intention to make their previous approval of the document, null and void.

**COMMISSIONERS' BRIEFING SESSION - Continued:** The Commissioners and County Administrator continued discussing recent meetings they attended, Point in Time count form, miscellaneous topics and reviewed upcoming meetings. The Commissioners also discussed contacting Washington State Department of Natural Resources regarding "leave" trees that were cut either as part of a harvest, or illegally cut after a harvest.

The meeting was recessed at 11:40 a.m. and reconvened at 1:31 p.m. with all three Commissioners present.

WORKSHOP re: Jefferson County Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (PRAB) 2022 Annual Report: Parks and Recreation Manager Matt Tyler introduced the Chair of the PRAB and member Susie Marshall. Manager Tyler and PRAB Chair Bessey provided information on the 2022 Annual Report.

**ADDITIONAL DISCUSSION ITEMS:** The Commissioners and County Administrator reviewed the following:

- ARPA Last Call Continued: The Commissioners reviewed the draft document that was
  presented on-screen for the public to view. After discussion, Commissioner Dean moved to
  replace the guidelines for Last Call ARPA Funds, from what was approved earlier today, to the
  revised and updated guidelines presented here. Commissioner Dean seconded the motion. Chair
  Brotherton called for public comments, and none were received. He called for a vote on the
  motion. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.
- Hood Canal Coordinating Council (HCCC) Dues: At the upcoming HCCC Annual Meeting, they will be requesting a \$7,500 increase in membership dues. Previous dues were \$2,500.
- Washington State Commerce Grant for solar panels and batteries for community centers
- Legislative update provided by Commissioner Dean
- Closing remarks
