SL provided a presentation re: Opioid Settlement Funds Update. An opioid settlement has been reached in the amount of \$430,249,769.02 and 50% of funds will go to the state and 50% of funds will go to local governments. These funds will be distributed over the next 17 years. The first two Jefferson County payments of \$34,504.34 and \$36,262.38 have been received. SBH-ASO can directly administer these funds on behalf of a County or release the funds directly to a county. Each county may choose how it wishes to expend these funds, in accordance with approved uses delineated in settlement.
