Statement of Issue: Change Order No. 1 with Seton Construction of Port Townsend, Washington.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: This change order includes increase in cost for additional potholes due to quantity increase; installation of concrete driveway which was not included in the original scope; and planning cost with bid item credits.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The amount for Change Order No. 1 is (\$46,909.27). The contract amount will decrease from \$4,997,707.00 to \$4,950,797.73. NOTE, the cost includes 9.1% sales tax. The project is funded at 100% by the Department of Ecology.

Recommendation: Public Works recommends that the Board authorize Change Order No. 1 with Seton Construction, and return one original to Public Works for further processing.
