Donkey Creek Tributary Culvert Replacement Project Clearwater Road MP 1.35, County Road No. 107508

Statement of Issue: Create a county project known as the Donkey Creek Tributary Culvert Replacement Project.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: Remove the fish passage barrier and improve county road infrastructure by replacing the culvert at Clearwater Road MP 1.35 with a new Aluminum Structural Plate culvert. This project is being funded and managed by Trout Unlimited and the Coast Salmon Partnership. Jefferson County will provide assistance with right-of-way acquisition, and coordination with design and construction.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The total estimated cost for Jefferson County Right-of-Way assistance, and coordination on design and construction is \$37,555. The design and construction coordination will be funded by the County Road Fund. Funding for Right-of-Way assistance is awaiting a funding decision from NOAA in August 2024, and will require a reimbursable, subrecipient agreement between Jefferson County and Trout Unlimited.

Recommendation: The Board is requested to sign one original of the Resolution to Create County Project.
