Subject: Resolution to Create County Project
Duckabush Estuary Restoration-Realignment Project

Statement of Issue: Create a county project known as the Duckabush Estuary Restoration-Realignment Project.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: This project will replace the US HWY101 causeway across the Duckabush Estuary with a bridge, and will also realign a segment of Duckabush Road, and replace a culvert with a bridge on Shore Drive. This project is being jointly funded and managed by the Washington State Dept. of Fish & Wildlife, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and WSDOT for a total estimated cost of \$126 million. Jefferson County will provide coordination on Preliminary Engineering.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The total estimated cost for Jefferson County coordination on Preliminary Engineering is \$6,500, which will come from the County Road Fund.

Recommendation: The Board is requested to sign one original of the Resolution to Create County Project.
