**Public Infrastructure Fund Request for Proposals Round** 

**STATEMENT OF ISSUE:** The Public Infrastructure Fund has accumulated enough fund balance to warrant another Request for Proposals round.

**ANALYSIS:** The Public Infrastructure Board met on August 24, 2023. The financial position of the fund was presented to the Board along with a recommendation that they approve a new Request for Proposals round with \$800,189 available to fund approved projects. The PIF Board approved the staff recommendation.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This request, in and of itself, has no fiscal impact. However, its approval will eventually lead to a fiscal impact of as much \$800,189 to be borne by the Public Infrastructure Fund – Fund 306.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Board of County Commissioners approve a Public Infrastructure Request for Proposals round in an amount not to exceed \$800,189.
