STATEMENT OF ISSUE:

On September 19, 2023 the LTAC Committee met to review presentations from the Jefferson County 2024 Lodging Tax Request for Proposals. re: 2024 Lodging Tax Funding Recommendations from the Lodging Tax Advisory Committee (LTAC).

ANALYSIS:

The Lodging Tax Advisory Committee has submitted recommendations for the 2024 Lodging Tax Fund allocations. In order for 2024 lodging tax funding agreements to be processed in a timely manner, the Commissioners are asked to review the LTAC recommendations and take action to affirm the 2024 funding amounts, including fifteen (15) proposals totaling \$720,400, plus \$14,752 for capital contingency and administrative costs for a total of \$749,904, as detailed in the attached spreadsheet.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$749,904 from Fund 125.

RECOMMENDATION:

Review the LTAC recommendations and approve a motion to adopt the 2024 Hotel Motel fund expenditures as recommended.
