# Why?

#### STATE OF WASHINGTON

**County of Jefferson** 

An Ordinance Relating to County Fee Policy and Requirements and Department of Public Works Parks and Recreation Division Fee Schedules; Amending Title 3 JCC, Title 12 JCC, and Appendix Fee Schedules; Repealing and Replacing Ordinance No. 05-0707-14 and Ordinance 12-1209-96

**ORDINANCE NO.** <u>02-0612-23</u>

- Under Chapter 3.80 JCC, Fees are taken out of the county code and adopted by resolution
- The old process lacked transparency, was cumbersome, and resulted in many out-of-date fee schedules remaining in the code
- Departments are now required to post fee schedules on website and make fee schedules widely available to the public

## How?

- The BoCC must adopt an ordinance that eliminates the existing fees in the code
- Then, the BoCC adopts a new resolution that establishes the new fee schedule, as required by chapter 3.80 JCC
- Important to adopt them in the following sequence, due to technical amendment of the Appendix Fee Schedules
  - Auditor
  - Sheriff
  - PRA Administrator
  - County Clerk
  - Public Health- Environmental Public Health

## Who and What Changes to Fees???

County Auditor- minor changes
County Sheriff- no changes
Public Records Act Administrator-no changes
Superior Court Clerk- no changes
Public Health/EPH – 6.01% increase across the board
