STATEMENT OF ISSUE:

The Department of Community Development (DCD) and The Jefferson County Fire Marshal Office (JCFMO) requests a public hearing to allow public comment for a private named road.

ANALYSIS:

JCFMO has received a properly submitted application to change the naming of a private named road: Mount Walker View Drive. The application has been distributed to interested public entities for comment in compliance with JCC 12.20.150. The E911 ordinance and JCC 12.20.150 state that a public hearing and public comments are to be reviewed and deliberated prior to new road name selection. Should the Board determine that a road name change be granted, a resolution is required.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There are no direct fiscal impacts as a result of this proposed update.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Board hold the hearing with public comment and take action by passing a resolution to adopt one of the three proposed road names.

WHY ARE WE HERE TODAY?

- Community Development (DCD) received an application for a "Road Name Petition" to rename Mt. Walker View Dr.
- The reason for this petition, as stated from the Petitioner is that "people come here to see Mt. Walker which in fact you can not see Mt. Walker from Mt Walker View Dr. As well deliveries have a issue."
- DCD has sent for comment per Jefferson County Code (JCC). We have actually repeated this step due to the lack of responses.
- Per ICC
 - All Parties addressed off of Mt. Walker View DR. have been contacted and notified of the purposed renaming of Mt. Walker View Dr.
 - All address numbers will remain the same as they are all correctly numbered per code.

JCC 12.20.150

- 1) Changing a road name may be initiated by a petition signed by at least 75 percent of the property owners adjoining the road. The petition shall specify a lead petitioner. Each owner shall have one vote regardless of how many parcels or addresses are owned or assigned. The petition shall list three names in order of preference. The petition shall be submitted to the designated department along with appropriate fees for processing the petition, the public hearing notice, reviewing emergency locator numbers, and installing new road name signs.
- The requirement for 75 percent of the property owners to petition shall be waived when the county or a fire district under JCC 18.20.140 identifies a road name that does not meet the criteria of this chapter and impairs emergency response. In such a case any property owner or group of property owners may petition to change the road name.
- (2) Within 15 business days from receipt of the petition, the county shall determine whether the petition is valid by confirming that sufficient valid signatures have been submitted. Petitions without sufficient valid signatures shall be denied.
- (3) Within 10 business days from the date that the petition has been validated, the proposed road names shall be reviewed to determine which names meet the road name criteria of this chapter. If the petition does not propose an acceptable name, it shall be returned to the lead petitioner. The petitioners may submit additional road names for review.
- (4) Within 15 business days of the determination that at least one of the proposed names is acceptable, the designated department shall submit an agenda request to the board to schedule a public hearing to consider the proposed road name change.

JCC 12.20.150 CONTINUED

- (5) Road name changes shall be reviewed by the board in a public hearing.
- (a) Notice of a public hearing on a proposed road name change shall be made by mail to property owners adjoining the road and all other affected persons or agencies. When a county road name is proposed to be changed, notice shall also be made by publishing in the newspaper of record. Notice shall be made at least 10 days prior to the hearing and shall state the name and location of the road proposed to be renamed, the proposed new names, and the date, time, and location of the hearing.
- (b) Within 30 business days of a proposed road name change being submitted to it, the board shall conduct a public hearing to review the proposed name change and comments by the public and affected agencies and take public testimony. The board shall determine whether the road name should be changed and, if so, the board shall select a new road name.
- (c) Road name changes shall be adopted by resolution.
- (6) Corrections to emergency locator numbers shall be coordinated with road name changes to minimize inconvenience to property owners. In conjunction with a road name change, the county shall review and correct emergency locator numbers to ensure that they meet the criteria of this chapter. [Ord. 1-10 § 15]



RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, Jefferson County Code Title 12 Public Ways and Places governs county uniform road naming, including chapter 12.20 JCC 911 Emergency Locator System; and,

WHEREAS, section 12.20.150 JCC authorizes road name changes for established private roads that have been properly named through Jefferson County; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 12.20.150 JCC, a petition was presented to the Jefferson County Department of Community Development (DCD) by at least 75 percent of the property owners adjoining the road for Walker View Drive to be renamed; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the property owners to rename the road considering Mt. Walker is not viewable from Walker View Drive located on the Coyle peninsula; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the property owners to rename the road considering the current name draws unintended attraction to the area in an attempt to view Mt. Walker; and,

WHEREAS, DCD having contacted all interested property owners currently addressed on Walker View Drive by mail; and,

WHEREAS, all three potential road names having been provided and commented on by interested agencies through two rounds of call for agency comment; and,

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board of County Commissioners having held a public hearing to review the road name change petition and determined the road name should be changed; and.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Whereas Clauses are Findings of Fact.</u> The Jefferson County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the above "Whereas" clauses as Findings of Fact.

<u>Section 2. Purpose.</u> The purpose of this resolution is to grant the petition of the property owners adjoining the private road Walker View Drive and adopt the new road name of Starry Night Place.

<u>Section 7. Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or section of this Resolution or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Resolution or its application to other persons or circumstances shall be fully valid and shall not be affected.

<u>Section 8. SEPA Categorical Exemption.</u> This Resolution is categorically exempt from the State Environmental Policy Act under WAC <u>197-11-800</u> (19).

<u>Section 9. Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon approval and adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
