DNR Representatives will discuss timber sales and revenue reports.

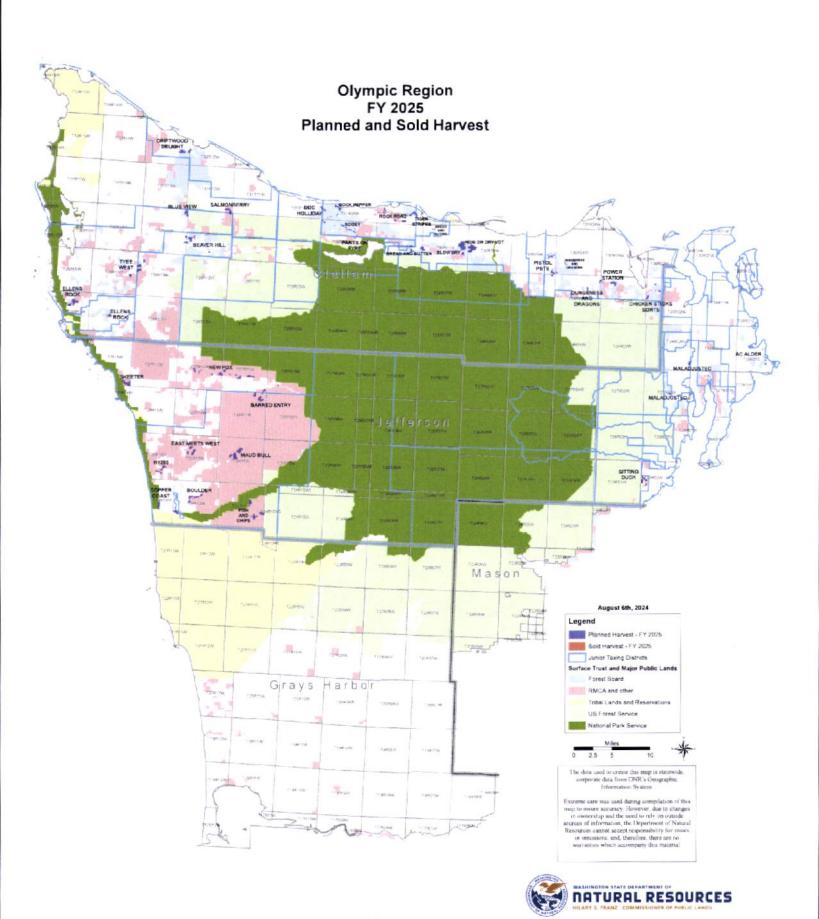
