Statement of Issue: Create a county project known as Gardiner Beach Road Boat Ramp Repair.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: This joint project with the Port of Port Townsend includes elevating a segment of Gardiner Beach Road to accommodate the Port's reconstruction of the existing boat ramp. The County's contribution will be applied to county road reconstruction and resurfacing. This project is #13 on the 2024-2029 TIP (Transportation Improvement Program) and #12 on the 2024 Annual Construction Program.

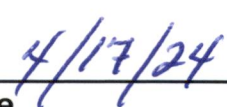
Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The Port of Port Townsend's estimate for construction is \$800,000. The County's \$50,000 contribution to the project will come from the Road Fund.
